

Adult Outpatient and Women's Mental Health Psychiatrist Worcester, MA

Jumpstart your professional career in outpatient and women's mental health working with national innovators at the UMass Memorial Health Care and the University of Massachusetts Medical School. The Department of Psychiatry at UMass Memorial Medical Center is seeking a psychiatrist with interest and experience in Women's Mental Health. This position, while primarily focusing on general outpatient care, will provide opportunities for integrating behavioral healthcare into obstetric and other medical settings through consultation and telepsychiatry for the right candidate. Clinical activities include prescription and management of medications, administration or recommendation of psychotherapeutic treatments, and collaboration with physicians, psychologists, social workers, psychiatric nurses, or other professionals.

Protected research time is available to qualified candidates. This will include the opportunity to work on existing NIH-funded clinical and implementation studies and help with grant submissions. The position also includes the opportunity to work on population-based statewide programs focused on building the capacity of the medical community to address perinatal mental health and substance use disorders in Massachusetts (www.mcpapformoms.org) and other states (www.lifeline4moms.org). The psychiatrist will be mentored to develop their own independent research with opportunities for publication and presentations. Current active research in the Lifeline for Moms Center includes CDC, NIMH, HRSA, and private and state-funded projects.
